The 100 Resource Learning Center is open to all Atlanta Public School (APS) students. Free individual tutoring services are available by making appointments with the 100 RLC Coordinator, Mr. Fred Parham. Each student signing up for tutoring will need to complete a pre-needs assessment with Mr. Parham to be assigned to an instructor on a specific date and time.

All APS parents are welcomed to enroll in the Parent Computer Literacy Training program with Ms. Margaret Wade. Parents are taught basic computer use such as typing and how to use Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access). GED classes are also available for parents.

The 100 RLC is conveniently located near Five Points Marta Station. Once students move upstairs in the middle section of the train station, they should walk towards Marietta & Broad Streets passing Burger King, CVS Pharmacy, McDonald's, etc. then cross Marietta Street to enter the 1st building on the left hand side of Broad Street. The 100 RLC is located in the same building as Bank of America and Georgia State University's J. Mack Robinson School of Business.
